work of collected data of that criterion from all the departments. It was decided to complete the data collection process on or before 13<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

The coordinator Dr. Dhanya Menon, who attended the SAAC district level workshop held at Vennala College Thrissur, briefed the members on the various issues that came up for discussion at the workshop. The KSHEC members who were the main speakers informed the group that they would inform all the colleges about the status of SAAC after holding similar workshops in all districts and collecting creative feedback from the concerned teachers.
