COLLEGE REPORT 2016-17

It is with immense pleasure and gratitude that I present before you the **22nd Annual Report** of the College activities of the academic year 2016-17. As you know, the Prajyoti Niketan Family consists of the Manager, the Principal, the Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff, Well-Wishers, Parents and Students. Our College is run by **Christian Charitable Society** and has been reaccredited with **'A' Grade** by the NAAC.

Courses & Programmes

We have **five aided Under-Graduate** Courses **and one aided Post-Graduate** Course. Besides, we have been very successfully conducting **four UGC sponsored Add-on Programmes**, such as **Communication Skills in English**, **Counselling Psychology**, **Web Technology** and **Yoga & Health Care**. We also conduct Kerala Government sponsored academic initiatives like **ASAP**, **WWS** and **SSP** along with **UGC Net Coaching**, **Bank and PSC Coaching** Programmes in association with **IMS** and **TIME** Thrissur. All these programmes provide opportunities for our students to pursue their studies as per their interest and aptitude.

Staff & Students

There are 34 teaching staff members including 27 permanent & 7 Guest Lecturers and 17 non-teaching staff members including 13 permanent & 4 temporary staff. At present, the College has a total strength of 628 students including 183 male and 445 female students.
