


#### **A Quiz Club and IQAC Initiative**

Mentoring can be defined as a reciprocal and collaborative open relationship that occurs between a teacher and a student or senior and junior employee for the purpose of the mentee's growth, learning, and overall development. For a formal mentoring relationship, there are actionable and measurable goals defined and set with determined requirements.


A good mentor can help and motivate the mentee become more effective at work, learn new skills, develop greater confidence, and make better decisions for their overall growth. Mentors can hep mentee to strengthen their technical, academic, leadership, interpersonal skills and experience new insights and ideas. Mentoring Models include One-on-One Mentoring, Group Mentoring, Peer Mentoring and so on. In schools and colleges most commonly implemented mentoring are one to one, group and peer mentoring. Here only the mentor and mentee or one or several mentors work with a group of mentees are involved in this type of mentoring, and it is usually a more-experienced individual paired with a less-experienced or much younger mentee. When there are not enough time or resources to have one mentor for each participant same role is shared or similar experiences in the professional lives. These peers pair up to offer support for each other. This can be a group or a one-on-one mentoring relationship.


### Webinar on 'COVID VACCINATION- AN AWARENESS PROGRAMME FOR YOUTH on April 29<sup>th</sup>





### **CONSTITUTION DAY NOVEMBER 26**



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
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# Suicide Prevention Day Observance by Research and Post Graduate Department of Psychology Prajyoti Niketan College Pudukad







# WEBINAR ON "NATIONAL MENTORING DAY"

#### Organized By Research And PG Department Of Psychology

#### 27 October, 2020

Mentoring can be defined as a reciprocal and collaborative open relationship that occurs between a teacher and a student or senior and junior employee for the purpose of the mentee's growth, learning, and overall development. Mentors chosen must act as role models for their mentee and provide guidance to help them reach their goals. Mentoring can be formal or informal and conducted in an informal environment, so as to help mentees to set goals. But they are usually not measurable and the relationships are unstructured. For a formal mentoring relationship, there are actionable and measurable goals defined and set with determined requirements.

A good mentor can help and motivate the mentee become more effective at work, learn new skills, develop greater confidence, and make better decisions for their overall growth. Mentors can hep mentee to strengthen their technical, academic, leadership, interpersonal skills and experience new insights and ideas. Mentoring Models include One-on-One Mentoring, Group Mentoring, Peer Mentoring and so on. In schools and colleges most commonly implemented mentoring are one to one, group and peer mentoring. Here only the mentor and mentee or one or several mentors work with a group of mentees are involved in this type of mentoring, and it is usually a more-experienced individual paired with a less-experienced or much younger mentee. When there are not enough time or resources to have one mentor for each participant same role is shared or similar experiences in the professional lives. These peers pair up to offer support for each other. This can be a group or a one-on-one mentoring relationship.

The aim of present National Mentoring day webinar session was to enlighten our knowledge with the role of mentor, mentee and importance of mentoring in tutoring and how it improves teacher student relationship. More over having a harmonious relationship between mentor and mentee will bring out changes in the academic, personal, social life. With this aim the Research and Post graduate Department of Psychology, Prajyoti Niketan College has organized one day Webinar on 27 October, 2020 on online google platform and Youtube live stram from 3.00pm to 4.00pm. The speaker on the day was Dr. Joju K T, former Associate Professorin Mathematics, Prajyoti Niketan College, Pudukad.

The webinar started with welcome speech by Sr.Julie Elizabeth (Research scholar). The session was presided by respected Dr.Shaijan Paul (Principal, Prajyoti Niketan College, Pudukad). They must be perceptive in anticipating challenges and encourage communication. They should maintain confidentiality to increase trust. Thus the session ended with Vote of thanks by Ms. Fatma.M.A(Research Scholar). 



































#### AIDS DAY REPORT 2020 DECEMBER 1

# Endowment Lecture – Dr. Varghese Paul and Dr. Moncy Edward October 16, 2020,

## Prajyoti Niketan College.

On the 16<sup>th</sup> of October, 2020, Prajyoti Niketan College tuned in to the Endowment Lecture held in honour of Dr. Varghese Paul, and Dr. Moncy Edward. Spearheaded by the dedicated alumni of the Research and Post-Graduate Department of Psychology, and co-ordinated by Dr. Nice Mary Francis, this online event was held in order to commemorate the achievements of the guests of honour, and to express the college's gratitude towards them. The session was graced by the presence of Rev. Fr. Dr. Harshajan Pazhayattil, Founder/Director of Prajyoti Niketan College. The principal, Dr. Shaijan Paul, and the Head of the Psychology Department, Dr. Milu Maria Anto were also among the virtual audience.

Dr. Varghese and Dr. Moncy had been an invaluable part of Prajyoti for over two decades, being the wind behind the wings of the Psychology department, before their retirement in 2018, and 2020, respectively. The Endowment Lecture was a tribute to these dedicated educators, who managed to truly touch the hearts of their students.

In accordance with the stellar careers of the guests of honour, the Lecture was engaging and educational. Dr. M S Razeena Padmam, and Dr. K Pramodu were the keynote speakers for the event.

Dr. Razeena, Rtd. Professor and Director of the School of Behavioural Science, M.G University, spoke about Coping During the Covid-19 Pandemic, and the declining mental health of the public. Quarantine and isolation have been extremely detrimental to the mental state of children and adults alike. Isolation, and the loss of loved ones both tend to leave the people in states of deep depression. The insecurity that comes with losing jobs, death anxiety, and fears surrounding the pandemic all add to the mix. Children lose out on socialization and play, which is extremely important for healthy development during formative years. The grief experienced by those who lost loved ones to the illness, and the guilt that occasionally comes with it runs largely unchecked. Suicide rates, especially among adolescents and young adults rose exponentially, as hundreds of people found themselves unable to get help or medical intervention.

Due to social distancing rules, therapy has been more inaccessible than usual. Adapting counselling and therapy to the online medium, and spreading awareness about the importance of mental health are imperative, and Dr. Razeena made a compelling case. She used examples to expand on her ideas, and welcomed every question the participants had, making the session cordial and engaging.

Sex is a topic that is regarded as taboo in our society. Dr. K. Pramodu, who is a sexologist, clinical psychologist, and the founder of Dr. Pramodu Institute of Sexual and Mental Health, aims to shatter this stigma surrounding sex and sexual health. His lecture was on the topic of Sexual Disorders, and he spoke about the importance of

sexual education, and sexual health. Contrary to popular belief, sexual disorders are not simply a product of physical complications, but psychological difficulties, as well. If an individual is facing significant challenges in attaining arousal, or pleasure during sex, they may be experiencing sexual dysfunction. There are individual differences in how people experience pleasure, and in their sexual performance, and interests. The four categories of sexual disorders – desire disorders, arousal disorders, orgasm disorders, and pain disorders were explained in detail. Psychological hurdles, and discomfort can play just as an important role in sexual activity as physiological issues. Diagnostic criteria according to the DSM-5, as well as general medicine, were elaborated on, and the importance of administering both mainstream medical treatment and psychological counselling simultaneously was emphasized. The concepts of consent, as well as sexual etiquette was discussed.

Several multinational studies conducted in the late 2010s point to nearly 40% of the general population experiencing drawbacks in sexual performance and interests. And yet, it is a topic that is very rarely talked about, due to social stigma. Dr. Pramodu's session was not only an illuminating lecture, but also an open forum for all discussions pertaining to sex and sexual health.

The guests of honour, Dr. Varghese and Dr. Moncy, were paragons of excellence and dedication, cherished by their students, and accomplished in their own right. The Endowment Lecture was an event that was truly worthy of its guests, as it was a labour of love which took the time to enthrall and educate its audience. Despite the event being conducted online, the resource persons captured the attention of the attendees till the very end, and interactive sessions went smoothly.


# REGIONAL WEBINAR ON "ORGANIZATIONAL BEHAVIOR:AN OVERVIEW"








# **Energy Conservation Webinar - Dec 17, 2021**




Day 1: 25.12.2021


Day 3: 27.12.2021







Day 4: 28.12.2021








Day 7: 31.12.2021

08th October 2017


The Word is moving towards the online mode and all of us need to be tamed with modern market trends.
